1. GOD HAS GIVEN US A COMMAND (28)

(Mat 21:28) "But what think ye? A certain man had two sons; and he came to the first, and said, Son, go work to day in my vineyard."

- A. The command is based upon a relationship (son) (28 a)
- B. The command is to go (28 b)

2. People Respond To This Command In Two Ways (29-30)

(Mat 21:29-30) "He answered and said, I will not: but afterward he repented, and went. {30} And he came to the second, and said likewise. And he answered and said, I go, sir: and went not."

- A. Some balk at it at first, but later go.
 - 1. Moses said, "I can't speak."

- 2. Jeremiah said, "I am just a child"
- 3. Gideon said, "I am the least of all"
- B. Some agree to go but don't follow through.

3. God Is Not Pleased With Mere Words (31-32)

(Mat 21:31-32) "Whether of them twain did the will of his father? They say unto him, The first. Jesus saith unto them, Verily I say unto you, That the publicans and the harlots go into the kingdom of God before you. {32} For John came unto you in the way of righteousness, and ye believed him not: but the publicans and the harlots believed him: and ye, when ye had seen it, repented not afterward, that ye might believe him."
