Text: 1 Samuel 16:7

Introduction:

  - a. His demand (Give me what's mine)
  - b. His departure (Chose to leave home)

  - f. His desertion (Sat alone)

A. The World Can Only See That Which Is Visible.

- 1. That is why we must not become a stumblingblock.
  - a. Rom. 14:13-22
    - 1. We are to not only stay away from the unclean, but also that the is look at by some as being unclean.
- 2. We're instructed to abstain from all appearance of evil (1 Thess. 5:22)
  - a. The casino boat for a meal.
  - b. A restaurant known as a bar, or saloon
  - c. Drinking virgin drinks
  - d. Playing the lottery
  - e. Listening to the wrong radio station
  - f. Watching the wrong TV shows.
  - g. Going to the homecoming dance, or prom.

#### h. Wearing certain clothes.
