# THE COMFORT OF HIS PRESENCE (VS. 1-3)

### Psalm 46:1-3

<sup>1</sup> God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. <sup>2</sup> Therefore will not we fear, though the earth be removed, and though the mountains be carried into the midst of the sea; <sup>3</sup> Though the waters thereof roar and be troubled, though the mountains shake with the swelling thereof. Selah.

A. The Truth of His Presence (vs. 1a)

### Psalm 46:1

<sup>1</sup> God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble.

"God is our refuge and strength"

This was a reference to the cities of refuge.

These cities were designed to aid and protect refugees on the run.

The problem is there were sometimes the refugee could not get to the city.

The truth is that when we cannot get to the place of refuge – God is our refuge.

B. The Trouble Outside of His Presence (1b)

#### Psalm 46:1

<sup>1</sup> God is our refuge and strength, <u>a very present help in</u> trouble.

C. The Trust within His Presence (2-3)

#### Psalm 46:2-3

<sup>2</sup> <u>Therefore will not we fear</u>, though the earth be removed, and though the mountains be carried into the midst of the sea; <sup>3</sup> Though the waters thereof roar and be troubled, though the mountains shake with the swelling thereof. Selah.

### 2. THE CONTROL OF HIS POWER (VS. 4-9)

#### Psalm 46:4-9

<sup>4</sup> There is a river, the streams whereof shall make glad the city of God, the holy place of the tabernacles of the most High. <sup>5</sup> God is in the midst of her; she shall not be moved: God shall help her, and that right early. <sup>6</sup> The heathen raged, the kingdoms were moved: he uttered his voice, the earth melted. <sup>7</sup> The LORD of hosts is with us; the God of Jacob is our refuge. Selah. <sup>8</sup> Come, behold the works of the LORD, what desolations he hath made in the earth. <sup>9</sup> He maketh wars to cease unto the end of the earth; he breaketh the bow, and cutteth the spear in sunder; he burneth the chariot in the fire.
