Introduction:

1. Particular Name

A. It's A Name Picked by the Father

The name Jesus was not given to our Lord by Mary and Joseph. It was a name handpicked by God, Matt. 1:21.

Matthew 1:21

²¹ And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins.

This alone makes it a name that stands out as special.

B. It's A Name that Paints God's Portrait

The name Jesus at once reveals the Son's mission.

Luke 19:10

¹⁰ For the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost.

The name Jesus reveals the Father's heart.

2 Peter 3:9

⁹ The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.

When the Father chose the name Jesus as the one His Son would bear during His time on earth, He was telling every creature in one word that His goal was the redemption and salvation of mankind.

Note not only Hs name is a Particular Name but also:

2. Pure Name (vs 10-11)

Philippians 2:10-11

¹⁰ That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth; ¹¹ And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

To every other name could be attached a list of the good and evils done by that person. To the name of Jesus, however, can only be attached praise, honor and worship. The Bible tells us that when this name is heard, it is to be reverenced.

Reverence involves:

A. Humility

The bowing of the knee is a clear sign of humility and reverence.

B. Honor

Not only will there be a bowing of knees before Jesus, but the name of Jesus will also be confessed by the lips of every creature. Men, angels and devils alike will join their voices in one mighty chorus and will together exalt the blessed name of Jesus Christ!

Note not only Hs name is a Particular and a Pure Name but also:

3. Purpose of His Name (vs 11)

Philippians 2:11

¹¹ And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, <u>to the glory of God the Father.</u>

His name should cause us to glorify God.
