Introduction:

1. THE OBLIGATION TO PRAISE (VS. 1)

Psalm 117:1

¹ O praise the LORD, all ye nations: praise him, all ye people.

- A. Repetition "O praise the Lord ... praise him ... Praise ye the Lord" (vv. 1a,b,2c).
- B. Races "all ye people" (v. 1c).

2. THE OCCASION FOR PRAISE (vs. 2)

Psalm 117:2

² For his merciful kindness is great toward us: and the truth of the LORD endureth for ever. Praise ye the LORD.

- A. His ExcellentTreatment "his merciful kindness" (v. 2a).
- B. His Enduring Truth "and the truth of the Lord endureth for ever" (v. 2b).

3. THE ONE TO PRAISE

Psalm 117:1-2

- ¹ O praise the LORD, all ye nations: praise him, all ye people. ² For his merciful kindness is great toward us: and the truth of the LORD endureth for ever. Praise ye the LORD.
 - A. Directed To Him Alone "the Lord" (vv. 1a,b,2c)
 - B. Done By All Alike "all" (v. 1c).
