# No Man Cared For My Soul Psalms 142

Text: Psalms 142:4

#### Psalm 142:4

<sup>4</sup> I looked on my right hand, and beheld, but there was no man that would know me: refuge failed me; no man cared for my soul.

#### Introduction:

David has been promised good things, but hasn't received them yet. Been ordained of God by the Prophet Samuel He is to be King of all Israel to have power, influence, wealth, a life of comfort, servants to wait on him.

For nearly 20 years he has had the promise one day David will be king! But.... Saul is still king, not only that, Saul is MAD. Anything sets him off. Not only is Saul mad but he is also jealous. Because of this David is on the run hiding in a cave for his life.

He is living in a cave with a band of 400 men, most of which were people that no one wanted around, those in debt, and discontented.

That brings us to the situation we have read about in our Text.

#### Psalm 142:2-6

<sup>2</sup> I poured out my complaint before him; I shewed before him my trouble. <sup>3</sup> When my spirit was overwhelmed within me, then thou knewest my path. In the way wherein I walked have they privily laid a snare for me. <sup>4</sup> I looked on my right hand, and beheld, but there was no man that would know me: refuge failed me; no man cared for my soul. <sup>5</sup> I cried unto thee, O LORD: I said, Thou art my refuge and my portion in the land of the living. <sup>6</sup> Attend unto my cry; for I am brought very low: deliver me from my persecutors; for they are stronger than I.

## Psalm 142:7

<sup>7</sup> Bring my soul out of prison, that I may praise thy name: the righteous shall compass me about; for thou shalt deal bountifully with me.
