What or who do you worship?

1. SOME WORSHIP PLEASURE

(James 5:5) "Ye have lived in pleasure on the earth, and been wanton; ye have nourished your hearts, as in a day of slaughter."

A. We live in a pleasure crazed society

(2 Tim 3:4) "Traitors, heady, highminded, lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God;"

2. SOME WORSHIP POSSESSIONS

(Luke 12:15) "And he said unto them, Take heed, and beware of covetousness: for a man's life consisteth not in the abundance of the things which he possesseth."

A. Many today are consumed with obtaining possessions.

(1 Tim 6:10) "For the love of money is the root of all evil: which while some coveted after, they have erred from the faith, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows."

3. SOME WORSHIP POPULARITY

(John 5:44) "How can ye believe, which receive honour one of another, and seek not the honour that cometh from God only?"

- A. Many people live today for the approval of man and praise of man.
- B. Some are willing to sell their very soul for the praise of man.

4. SOME WORSHIP POSITION

(John 6:27) "Labour not for the meat which perisheth, but for that meat which endureth unto everlasting life, which the Son of man shall give unto you: for him hath God the Father sealed."

A. Position is not important.

(Mat 6:33) "But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you."
