Text: Matt 26:15

(Mat 26:15) "And said unto them, What will ye give me, and I will deliver him unto you? And they covenanted with him for thirty pieces of silver."

Introduction:

One of the problems today in our society is with our value system.

For the most part America no longer has a value system of what is right. We all have different values.

How did we get this way?

We forsook the Word of God.

C. A Sinner

(Mat 26:15) "And said unto them, What will ye give me, and I will deliver him unto you? And they covenanted with him for thirty pieces of silver."
