Numbers 13:22-23

And they ascended by the south, and came unto Hebron; where Ahiman, Sheshai, and Talmai, the children of Anak, *were*. (Now Hebron was built seven years before Zoan in Egypt.) ²³ And they came unto the brook of Eshcol, and cut down from thence a branch with one cluster of grapes, and they bare it between two upon a staff; and *they brought* of the pomegranates, and of the figs.

2. THE GIANTS OF IMMENSE OPPOSITION

A. Giant of Discouragement.

Numbers 32:9

For when they went up unto the valley of Eshcol, and saw the land, they discouraged the heart of the children of Israel, that they should not go into the land which the Lord had given them.

B. Giant of Difficulty - It's too hard.

You can do as much as you think you can, But you'll never accomplish more; If you're afraid of yourself. There's little for you in store.

For fear comes from the inside first, It's there if you only knew it. And you can win, though you face the worst, If you feel that you can do it.
