## EPHESIANS 1:

Text: Ephesians 1:18

## **Ephesians 1:18**

<sup>18</sup> The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints,

#### Introduction:

Up to this point in the book of Ephesians, Paul has been praising the Lord. In one long sentence that begins in verse 3 and ends in verse 14, Paul portrays the heights and majesty of God.

He describes in great detail the amazing riches we possess in the Lord.

He also tells us all that God has done for us to bring us to Christ and to guarantee our eternal salvation.

Paul now lets them know what he desires for them to know.

#### Notice:

# 1. HE WANTED THEM TO KNOW MORE OF THE PERSON OF CHRIST (VS. 17)

## Ephesians 1:17

<sup>17</sup> That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him:

Knowledge of God must come from God.

God has revealed Himself in His Word.

Our responsibility is to get to know Him by getting to know the Saviour and the Scripture.

There is no greater knowledge on this earth.

A. W. Tozer wrote over 30 years ago, "It is my opinion that the Christian conception of God current in these middle years of the twentieth century is so decadent as to be utterly beneath the dignity of the Most High God and actually to constitute for professed believers something amounting to a moral calamity.

He goes on to say, "The heaviest obligation lying upon the Christian Church today is to purify and elevate her concept of God until it is once more worthy of Him and of her" Great truth is found in this statement. If you were to ask most Christians today to list 10 attributes of God many would find it very difficult.

#### Remember God is:

 Omniscient - having complete or unlimited knowledge, awareness, or understanding; perceiving all things.

#### Psalm 139:1-6

<sup>1</sup> O LORD, thou hast searched me, and known me. <sup>2</sup> Thou knowest my downsitting and mine uprising, thou understandest my thought afar off. <sup>3</sup> Thou compassest my path and my lying down, and art acquainted with all my ways. <sup>4</sup> For there is not a word in my tongue, but, lo, O LORD, thou knowest it altogether. <sup>5</sup> Thou hast beset me behind and before, and laid thine hand upon me. <sup>6</sup> Such knowledge is too wonderful for me; it is high, I cannot attain unto it.

## God knows:

- o Where I go
- What I think
- What I do
- What I say

God's knowledge is high which we cannot attain it.

## Psalm 147:5

- <sup>5</sup> Great is our Lord, and of great power: his understanding is infinite.
  - Omnipotent almighty or infinite in power

#### Genesis 18:14

<sup>14</sup> Is any thing too hard for the LORD?</sup> At the time appointed I will return unto thee, according to the time of life, and Sarah shall have a son.

#### Psalm 61:2-3

<sup>2</sup> From the end of the earth will I cry unto thee, when my heart is overwhelmed: lead me to the rock that is higher than I. <sup>3</sup> For thou hast been a shelter for me, and a strong tower from the enemy.

Because of His power He is:

Our source of strength

We cannot serve Him in our own strength. We can only serve Him in the strength He gives us.

He will multiply both the bread and the fishes so that there is sufficient for everyone to be filled. There will be more than enough.

- <sup>17</sup> Ah Lord GOD! behold, thou hast made the heaven and the earth by thy great power and stretched out arm, and there is nothing too hard for thee:
  - Omnipresent present everywhere at the same time

<sup>3</sup> The eyes of the LORD are in every place, beholding the evil and the good.

#### Psalm 121:3

<sup>3</sup> He will not suffer thy foot to be moved: he that keepeth thee will not slumber.

#### Jeremiah 23:23-24

<sup>23</sup> Am I a God at hand, saith the LORD, and not a God afar off? <sup>24</sup> Can any hide himself in secret places that I shall not see him? saith the LORD. Do not I fill heaven and earth? saith the LORD.

shall be light about me. <sup>12</sup> Yea, the darkness hideth not from thee; but the night shineth as the day: the darkness and the light are both alike to thee.

He is Everlasting with No Beginning or Ending

<sup>25</sup> Of old hast thou laid the foundation of the earth: and the heavens are the work of thy hands. <sup>26</sup> They shall perish, but thou shalt endure: yea, all of them shall wax old like a garment; as a vesture shalt thou change them, and they shall be changed: <sup>27</sup> But thou art the same, and thy years shall have no end.

#### Malachi 3:6

- <sup>6</sup> For I am the LORD, I change not; therefore ye sons of Jacob are not consumed.
  - Incomprehensible or Beyond Our Understanding

<sup>7</sup> Canst thou by searching find out God? canst thou find out the Almighty unto perfection?

#### Job 26:14

- <sup>14</sup> Lo, these are parts of his ways: but how little a portion is heard of him? but the thunder of his power who can understand?
  - He is Self-Existent Depending on Nothing For His Existence

#### John 5:26

- <sup>26</sup> For as the Father hath life in himself; so hath he given to the Son to have life in himself;
  - He Is Self-Sufficient

<sup>12</sup> If I were hungry, I would not tell thee: for the world is mine, and the fulness thereof.

## Exodus 34:6-7

<sup>6</sup> And the LORD passed by before him, and proclaimed, The LORD, The LORD God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abundant in goodness and truth, <sup>7</sup> Keeping mercy for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, and that will by no means clear the guilty; visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the

children, and upon the children's children, unto the third and to the fourth generation.

Truthful

#### **Psalm 31:5**

<sup>5</sup> Into thine hand I commit my spirit: thou hast redeemed me, O LORD God of truth.

- <sup>2</sup> In hope of eternal life, which God, that cannot lie, promised before the world began;

## **Deuteronomy 7:9**

<sup>9</sup> Know therefore that the LORD thy God, he is God, the faithful God, which keepeth covenant and mercy with them that love him and keep his commandments to a thousand generations;

## 1 Thessalonians 5:24

- <sup>24</sup> Faithful is he that calleth you, who also will do it.
  - Jealous

## Exodus 20:5

<sup>5</sup> Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me;

#### Nahum 1:2

<sup>2</sup> God is jealous, and the LORD revengeth; the LORD revengeth, and is furious; the LORD will take vengeance on his adversaries, and he reserveth wrath for his enemies.

These are just a few attributes but we can certainly see why Paul desired for the Ephesians to have this knowledge.
