50 And Adonijah feared because of Solomon, and arose, and went, and caught hold on the horns of the altar.

I will Be King (vs 5)

- A. The thing desired was right enough in its self.
 - 1. Leadership is of God.
 - 2. Someone must be in charge.
- B. But Adonijah wasn't the right man for this position.
 - 1. God had chosen Solomon
- C. So Adonijah set out to defeat God.
 - 1. Adonijah was easily defeated.

3. THE END OF THE CAREER OF THIS YOUNG MAN

- A. He lost his friends
 - 1. When the thing was found out "every man went his way".
- B. He lost his honor
 - 1. (vs 50)
- C. He lost his life.
 - 1. A little later He was caught in a snare set for Solomon.
