- C. The consideration of Ills gentleness The Lord comforted!

3. How Complete Are the Provisions of God

- A. The Lord served Elijah The Lord prepared it.
- B. The Lord satisfied Elijah he received it.
- C. The Lord sustained Elijah 40 days & nights
