#### **Psalms 140:1**

<sup>1</sup> Deliver me, O LORD, from the evil man: preserve me from the violent man;

## Introduction:

David reflects upon the perils that befall him because of his enemy, probably Saul, and He trusts in the protection of God.

## 1. DAVID'S PRAYER REGARDING THE UNRIGHTEOUS (VS. 1-11)

A. What they do (vss. 1-5)

### Psalms 140:1-5

<sup>1</sup> Deliver me, O LORD, from the evil man: preserve me from the violent man; <sup>2</sup> Which imagine mischiefs in *their* heart; continually are they gathered together *for* war. <sup>3</sup> They have sharpened their tongues like a serpent; adders' poison *is* under their lips. Selah. <sup>4</sup> Keep me, O LORD, from the hands of the wicked; preserve me from the violent man; who have purposed to overthrow my goings. <sup>5</sup> The proud have hid a snare for me, and

cords; they have spread a net by the wayside; they have set gins for me. Selah.

- 1. They imagine mischief in their heart
- 2. They gather together for war
- 3. They have sharp tongues
- 4. Poison is in their mouth
- 5. They try to ensnare David
- B. What they deserve (vss. 6-10)

#### Psalms 140:6-10

<sup>6</sup> I said unto the LORD, Thou *art* my God: hear the voice of my supplications, O LORD. <sup>7</sup> O GOD the Lord, the strength of my salvation, thou hast covered my head in the day of battle. <sup>8</sup> Grant not, O LORD, the desires of the wicked: further not his wicked device; *lest* they exalt themselves. Selah. <sup>9</sup> *As for* the head of those that compass me about, let the mischief of their own lips cover them. <sup>10</sup> Let burning coals fall upon them: let them be cast into the fire; into deep pits, that they rise not up again.

- 1. Not to meet their desires
- 2. Not to further their devices
- 3. Let the mischief of their lips cover them

- 4. Burn them by coals of fire, be cast into the fire
- 5. Be thrown into deep pits

## 2. David's Prayer Regarding the Righteous (vs. 140:12-13)

A. The Recognition (vs.12)

#### Psalms 140:12

<sup>12</sup> I know that the LORD will maintain the cause of the afflicted, *and* the right of the poor.
