

# THE WAY, THE TRUTH, AND THE LIFE

## JOHN 14:1-31

Text: John 14:6

### **John 14:6**

<sup>6</sup> Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

Introduction:

## **1. THERE IS HOPE FOR TOMORROW (VS 2-3)**

### **John 14:2-3**

<sup>2</sup> In my Father's house are many mansions: if *it were* not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. <sup>3</sup> And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, *there* ye may be also.

He speaks of:

- A. A Heavenly Home (vs 2)
- B. A Heavenly Hope (vs 3)
- C. A Heavenly Homecoming (vs 3)

## **2. THERE IS HELP FOR TODAY (VS 4-31)**

There is help in the matter of:

## A. Salvation (vs 4-11)

### **John 14:4-11**

<sup>4</sup> And whither I go ye know, and the way ye know. <sup>5</sup> Thomas saith unto him, Lord, we know not whither thou goest; and how can we know the way? <sup>6</sup> Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me. <sup>7</sup> If ye had known me, ye should have known my Father also: and from henceforth ye know him, and have seen him. <sup>8</sup> Philip saith unto him, Lord, shew us the Father, and it sufficeth us. <sup>9</sup> Jesus saith unto him, Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known me, Philip? he that hath seen me hath seen the Father; and how sayest thou *then*, Shew us the Father? <sup>10</sup> Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me? the words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works. <sup>11</sup> Believe me that I *am* in the Father, and the Father in me: or else believe me for the very works' sake.

In these verses we notice:

1. How to be saved – He is the way.
2. How to be sure you're saved – He is the truth.
3. How to be satisfied – He is the life.

## B. Service (vs 12-14)

### **John 14:12-14**

<sup>12</sup> Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater *works* than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father. <sup>13</sup> And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. <sup>14</sup> If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do *it*.

1. He will honor us (vs 12)
2. He will hear us (vs 13-14)
3. He will help us (vs 13-14)

### C. Surrender (vs 15, 19-24)

#### **John 14:15**

<sup>15</sup> If ye love me, keep my commandments.

#### **John 14:19-24**

<sup>19</sup> Yet a little while, and the world seeth me no more; but ye see me: because I live, ye shall live also. <sup>20</sup> At that day ye shall know that I *am* in my Father, and ye in me, and I in you. <sup>21</sup> He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me: and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him. <sup>22</sup> Judas saith unto him, not Iscariot, Lord, how is it that thou wilt manifest thyself unto us, and not unto the world? <sup>23</sup> Jesus answered and said unto him, If a man love me, he will keep my words: and my Father will love him, and we will come unto him, and make our abode with him. <sup>24</sup> He that loveth me not keepeth not my sayings: and the word which ye hear is not mine, but the Father's which sent me.
