JOB 22:15

Text: Job 22:15

(Job 22:15 KJV) "Hast thou marked the old way which wicked men have trodden?"

#### Introduction:

Marking the Old Way involves: to hedge about, guard; to protect, attend to, beware, be circumspect, take heed, mark, look narrowly, observe, preserve, regard, reserve, save, sure, watchman).

Our text is telling us to mark to old way. What it is telling us is to learn from the mistakes of others. You can see where it has led so learn from it. Mark the old way. Learn from the mistakes and learn what path to take.

Things were marked in the Bible with Landmarks. See Deu 19:14; Deu 27:14; Prov 22:28; Prov 23:10

(Deu 19:14 KJV) "Thou shalt not remove thy neighbour's landmark, which they of old time have set

in thine inheritance, which thou shalt inherit in the land that the LORD thy God giveth thee to possess it."

(Deu 27:14 KJV) "And the Levites shall speak, and say unto all the men of Israel with a loud voice,"

(Prov 22:28 KJV) "Remove not the ancient landmark, which thy fathers have set."

(Prov 23:10 KJV) "Remove not the old landmark; and enter not into the fields of the fatherless:"

### 2. PREPARATION OF THE LANDMARK

- A. One must mark out the boundary.
- B. One learns the path to mark from God's word.

A. Don't remove them.

See Deu 27:17

(Deu 27:17 KJV) "Cursed be he that removeth his neighbour's landmark. And all the people shall say, Amen."

## 4. Preserved

A. Prayer

See Luke 11:1

(Luke 11:1 KJV) "And it came to pass, that, as he was praying in a certain place, when he ceased, one of his disciples said unto him, Lord, teach us to pray, as John also taught his disciples."

1. Prayer is the only thing learned to do by praying.

Illustration:

You never learn how to swim until you jump into the water.

(Read: The Death Notice)
